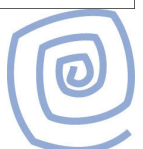

Please read these terms and conditions carefully. If you submit an applications for 'Cries for Peace' you are saying that you accept all these terms.

General

1. All entries must be received by 12:00 noon on Friday 8th of August 2008.
2. The entry must be around the theme of 'Peace'
3. Entries from outside of London are welcome
4. You can submit more than one entry but use separate application forms provided by Spiraluniverse for each.
5. The competition is open to all individuals and groups where the responsible person is 12 years or over to enter the competition. If you are under 18 on the 30 October 2008, you will need to get written permission from your parent or guardian.
6. Entry to the competition is free.
7. Spiraluniverse reserves the right to disqualify any entrants and their submissions if they do not comply with our terms and conditions.
8. You must own the copyright to your submissions and you need to ensure that you have permission from the actors, location owners, music owners and any other relevant persons in order to include them in your film.
9. You agree to give Spiraluniverse an unlimited, royalty-free, transferable, right and license to use reproduce, modify, adapt, publish, translate, create derivate works from, distribute, perform, display, make available to the public, broadcast transmit the content by all forms of media (including print and online) throughout the world.
10. Spiraluniverse reserves the right to reject any entries that do not promote peace in London.
11. Spiraluniverse will not be liable for any technical, hardware or software failures which may limit the entrants ability to participate in the competition.
12. There is no cash alternative for any of the prizes.
13. The judges shortlist is final and no correspondence will be entered into in respect of this decision.
14. The public vote result is final, only the winning entrant will be contacted, and no correspondence will be entered into in respect of this decision.
15. By entering, you give Spiraluniverse to use your name, entries and other details for news and general publicity purposes. Short listed entrants should be ready to make themselves available in the month of September 2008 for any follow up publicity or promotion.
16. Spiraluniverse reserves the right to substitute the prize for one of equal or greater value at any time.

Photography

1. Photographs must be submitted in jpeg format, and the description of the entry must specify the where, when and why the photograph was taken.
2. The photograph must be the entrants own work
3. Any photographs depicting inappropriate images will not be accepted

Short Film

1. Your short film should not be longer than 90 seconds, including any introductions, titles or credits. Entries over 90 seconds will not be accepted.
2. If any language other than English is used, it must be specified and subtitled in English for the entirety of the film.
3. Any short films containing inappropriate material such as defamatory, racist or obscene language, sexual activity or distressing scenes will not be accepted.
4. For health reasons, please avoid using very quick cuts or flashing images in your short film.
